US #1 Oranges – Sm. Boxes only

Texas Grapefruit – Sm. and Large Boxes

Washington Apples (Delicious, Gala & Granny Smith) - Small boxes only

Pears - Washington D'Anjou – Sm. box

String Cheese and beef summer sausage - Wisconsin

Cheese Cups and beef Sausage - Wisconsin (contains 1 meat and 2 cheese tubs)

(One tub cheddar, one tub garden vegetable)

Whole Cashews - 15 oz. in gift tin

Natural Pistachios - 3 lb bag

Pecan Jamborees - 12 oz in gift tin

Fruit Gems - **1 lb box**

English Toffee - 8 oz in a box (no gift tin).

Raspberry Gummies - 18 oz in a gift tin

Walnut Fudge – 14 oz in a box

Know the prices and sizes of fruit containers

Small boxes of fruit are about 20 lbs and large are about 40 lbs

USE THE PHONE!!! GO DOOR TO DOOR LAST! (NOT IN GFHS AREA!)

Fruit will be delivered beginning on Thursday, December 11th. Take money if they insist.

TAKE CARE OF YOUR PACKET!

Don't leave money in your packet in your locker!

Keep your packet with the yellow slips in it for your information at delivery time and save it for next year in case your pink slips are lost.

TURN IN SALES PROCEDURE - Turn in **Only the Pink Copies of your sales.** Fill out a **Yellow TALLY SHEET** and staple it on top of your sales slips.

TURN IN MONEY by filling out a **White Receipt Form** and be sure to include a total amount!

You take the pink copy for your records. When the money has been recounted you will receive a yellow receipt with your amount verified or request for you to recount.

 - First Day High Seller turned in sales - in each class - \$10.00**
 - Top Group Contest Highest Average receives \$200 from Shane Meskeman**
 - Top Second Groups Highest Average receives \$100 from Shane Meskeman**
- 4. More than one music class**
 - Turn in to the first class you have each day - we will compute the profit to share with the other class.**
- 5. Need for accurate records**

 - Check computer listing when posted to make sure mistakes have not been made**
