Style refers to the characteristics of the music that distinguish it from other types of music. This can refer to the historical period of the work (Medieval, Renaissance, Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Modern) or popular music (jazz, rock, blues, punk, hip-hop, country). Form refers to how the music is put together (ABA, Rondo, Blues, 32 bar song form, Verse/Chorus, etc. Pattern of Events refers to the order of things in the song (introduction, themes, soloists, etc. Just do a narrative of the sequence of new items introduced). Instruments Used refers to the different colors and timbres that are introduced into the musical fabric. Be specific (full orchestra at the introduction, the oboe is used on the main theme, the alto sax solo after the trumpet solo, etc.)!
