Travel Regulations and Other Stuff you need to know.

All Great Falls Public School Travel Regulations will be in effect the entire trip. These are found in your student handbook. Pay close attention to the policy on the use of drugs and alcohol.

Make sure you complete the concert/clinic assignments. You will turn these into me on the bus ride home. Please do not turn them in early.

No jeans will be worn while we are at the Jazz Festival or while we are on the bus and in the public eye. We will wear dress clothes for our performances (Men, trousers, shirt, tie. Ladies nice pants/skirt and blouse or a dress). Plan your packing appropriately! On the return trip on Saturday you may wear jeans and other casual school appropriate clothes.

Hotel Rooms must always be neat and kept up. Turn in keys to me at the end of our stay--I will check your room and then I will check us out of the motel.

Wear a watch or be able to read the light patterns of Western Wyoming. Tardiness at any time is INEXCUSABLE.

Be courteous on the bus--headphones are needed for stereos, conversations need to be at low levels, you need to be in a seat at all times, and keep the bus clean--use the garbage!

You are responsible for your own gear at all times (luggage, music, instrument, equipment). Don't assume that someone else will do it for you!

You will be given the standard school per diem of \$4 for lunch and \$8 for dinner for food if you made your fruit goal. The hotel is providing us continental breakfast, so eat there and save money. If you think you need more food money than that, bring extra funds. You may also want to buy snacks, souvenirs, and recordings of the jazz artists on the trip as well, so plan accordingly--and remember Wyoming has a sales tax!

There are four concert critique forms attached to this itinerary. You must attend the Russtones/Blue Notes concert and fill one of these out for their performance. You will need to attend 1 other performance throughout the day and complete a critique. Critiques can be combos, solos, or big bands.
